

Victorian Child Safety Standards

All sporting clubs are required to comply with the Standards.

This involves more than simply having volunteers complete a Working With Children (WWC) check.

Does your club have:

- A process for ensuring WWC checks are up to date?
- A Child Safe Policy or Statement to commitment to child safety?
- A Code of Conduct with clear expectations for appropriate behaviour with children?
- Processes for responding to and reporting suspected child abuse?
- Policies on volunteer recruitment
- Strategies to promote participation and empowerment of children?

If you answered “No” to any of these questions your Club is not meeting the Standards.

You are invited to attend a free Child Safety Standards workshop to begin the process of making your club child friendly and compliant with the Standards.
